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Investing in Innovation Fund - Update

March 11, 2010

On Monday March 8, 2010, U.S. Secretary of Education Arne Duncan released the Department of Education's (DOE) <u>final priorities</u> for grants under the \$650 million Investing in Innovation Fund (i3 grants). The i3 grants are part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) and are directed toward individual school districts or groups of school districts and entrepreneurial nonprofits partnering with school districts. Although states are not eligible to apply, there may be ways in which states could assist districts or consortiums with their grant applications.

Timeline

• Intent to apply due: April 1, 2010 (not required but strongly encouraged by the DOE)

Final application due: May 11, 2010

Applications reviewed: Late spring/summer 2010

• Grants announced: September, 2010

Cost Sharing or Matching

- Eligible applicants must obtain private sector matching funds or in-kind donations equal to at least 20% of its grant award.
- Following peer review of applications, an award will not be made unless the applicant provides adequate evidence that the full 20% match has been committed or the Secretary approves the eligible applicant's request to reduce the matching-level requirement.

• The Secretary may consider decreasing the matching requirement in the most exceptional circumstances, on a case-by-case basis.
