## Assessment Bills, 2015-16



### **ASSESSMENT BILLS 2015**

- **HB** 2655: Permits general opt-out of statewide assessments. Six-year sunset. Very specific about requirements around notification, rights of parents, and appropriate data use. Enrolled.
- **HB 2680**: Prohibits evaluation of teachers based upon statewide testis for one year. Enrolled.
- **HB 2835**: Would have prohibited implementation of "common core." Died in committee.

## The Legislature, ODE, and ESSA



### ESSA AND ODE

- The Oregon Department of Education has begun a year-long process for ESSA implementation.
- The plan involves multiple work groups, stakeholder conversations, and "road shows."
- The Legislature thus far seems mostly concerned with increased flexibility afforded by ESSA, specifically around assessments, as well as not being as concerned with the potential loss of federal funds because of the HB 2655 opt-out.

- Presented to State Board for review in Oct; for approval in Dec.
