



## **Ohio State Profile**

State profiles for the data visualization and 50-State Comparison on postsecondary governance structures summarize information about coordinating boards/agencies and governing boards, administrative/service agencies, advisory groups and membership organizations. The most in-depth information is provided for statewide and major postsecondary systemwide coordinating boards/agencies and governing boards.

*Note:* This resource does not include information related to setting tuition rates, administering funding formulas or allocating funds. The state profile information is based primarily on statutes, codes and state and postsecondary system board/agency policies. To the extent possible, Education Commission of the States reached out to state and system officials to verify our information.

## **State Overview**

Ohio's Department of Higher Education is a statewide coordinating agency for postsecondary education and oversees authorization of and program approval for independent institutions. The department is responsible for duties common to administrative agencies and coordinating boards since the Ohio Board of Regents serves in an advisory capacity to the chancellor (executive officer). These responsibilities include developing strategic plans, advising state policy leaders, approving new academic programs, administering academic and student financial aid programs, and providing data and reporting services. The governor, with confirmation by the Senate, appoints the department's chancellor. Ohio's four- and two-year institutions are governed by local boards and are not part of postsecondary systems.
