How are students using financial aid in your state?


Students use a variety of [funding sources](#) to pay for college. Students enrolled in public postsecondary institutions receive a total of

\$745.6 MILLION in federal financial aid, state financial aid, institutional financial aid and student loans.

#1 Oregon Opportunity Grant

\$57.3 million disbursed to **36,078** recipients.

#2 Student Child Care Grant

\$461,000 disbursed to **81** recipients.
